What does Flex Schedule mean? Flex Schedule will allow families to customize their early childhood scheduling needs. For example if you need:

- 3 half days – Monday, Wednesday, Friday
- 5 full days – Monday – Friday
- 2 days (full or half) – Monday & Friday

These are just some examples!

How will Flex Schedule affect the curriculum? Teachers plan weekly or multi-week themed units. Each child will receive instruction in daily whole group activities (calendar, play, read alouds, etc.) but also small group activities (crafts, themed lessons, etc.).

How will this affect student numbers? To best serve our students we will try to follow a 10 to 1 ratio in the Preschool Room. As enrollment reaches these numbers we will add aide support in the room.

If during the year we need more time, can we add on? Yes! Please contact your child’s teacher and the office to discuss a change.

If my child attends full day, what will happen at lunch time? As is the current practice, students who are full day will have the option to purchase a school lunch or bring a cold lunch from home.

Children are required to be potty trained to attend. If they have more than one accident a week after the first two weeks of attendance they will be asked to leave and be able to return once they are fully trained.
